DESCRIPTION

Assist participants as they navigate the more challenging areas of the courses by signing up as a Course Attendant. This position requires volunteers to direct 5K and 10K participants on key areas of the route with color-coded directional signs. Volunteers will be provided with safety vests and color-coded arrows. Position may be covered by a group or series of individuals.

REQUIREMENTS

Volunteers must be able to stand in one place for approximately one hour
Volunteers must be able to provide their own transportation from Towering Pines Park to one of the following locations:

VOLUNTEER LOCATION PARKING

WHAT YOU GET FOR VOLUNTEERING

Volunteers will receive free refreshments provided by the Salvation Army Emergency Disaster Services, Volunteer Event Tee, Volunteer Parking, and Community Service Approval.

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF YOU

Volunteers assisting with Run for the Fallen must be over the age of 18, or accompanied by a parent, guardian or chaperone that is at least 18 years old.

Volunteers must be able to follow written or verbal instructions as provided by Event Staff.

During their shift, Volunteers are expected to devote their full attention to Run for the Fallen, and maintain respectful, professional conduct at all times.

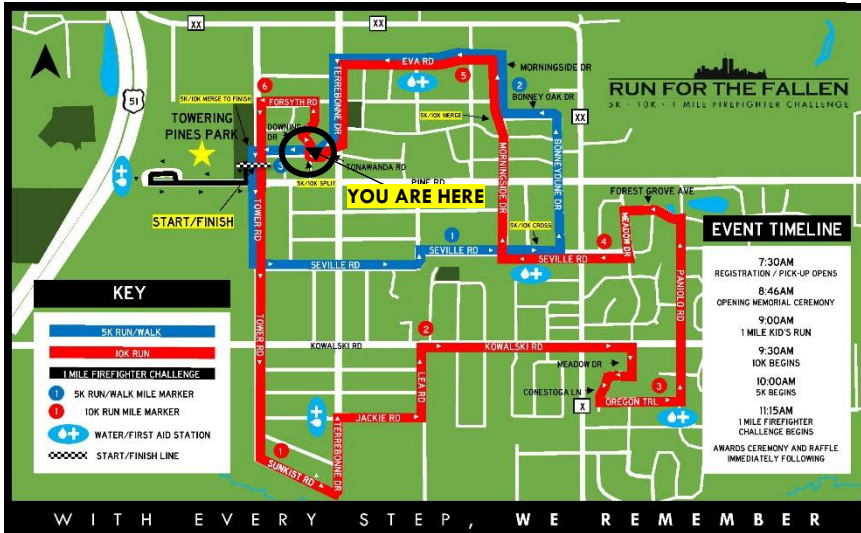
TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PLEASE STAND NEAR THIS LOCATION WHEN DIRECTING RUNNERS.

OPTIONAL:
VOLUNTEERS ARE INVITED TO BRING CHAIRS AND MAY SIT WHILE WAITING FOR RUNNERS TO ARRIVE. PLEASE ENSURE THAT SIGN HOLDERS ARE STANDING AND EASILY VISIBLE WHEN PARTICIPANTS ARE PRESENT.

INSTRUCTIONS

COURSE ATTENDANTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO HELP DIRECT RUNNERS ON ONE OF THE MOST INTEGRAL TURNS ON THE 5K/10K ROUTE. BE ADVISED, 5K AND 10K RUNNERS ARE RUNNING IN OPPOSITE DIRECTIONS ON THIS STRETCH OF THE COURSE. THIS SITE WILL ALSO BE ADEQUATELY MARKED WITH ROAD MARKERS IN ADDITION TO HAVING VOLUNTEERS AVAILABLE TO KEEP THE RUNNERS ON COURSE.

THE 5K/10K EVENTS ARE COLOR CODED. **5K ROUTE MARKERS, RACE BIBS, AND SIGNS ARE BLUE. 10K ROUTE MARKERS, RACE BIBS AND SIGNS ARE RED**

10K ATTENDANT:

10K ATTENDANT SHOULD DIRECT RUNNERS WEARING RED BIBS TO TURN **RIGHT/NORTH** ON TO **DOWNING DRIVE** WITH THE RED SIGN

5K ATTENDANT:

5K ATTENDANT SHOULD DIRECT RUNNERS WEARING BLUE BIBS TO CONTINUE **STRAIGHT/WEST** ON **TONAWANDA ROAD** WITH THE BLUE SIGN

CONDUCT:

PLEASE MAINTAIN RESPECTFUL, PROFESSIONAL BEHAVIOR AT ALL TIMES. COURSE ATTENDANTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO CHEER ON PARTICIPANTS.

CLEAN-UP/END OF SHIFT:

THE KRONENWETTER FIRE DEPARTMENT FOLLOW VEHICLES WILL INDICATE WHEN THE LAST RUNNER HAS PASSED YOUR STATION. PLEASE WAIT FOR THE **SECOND** VEHICLE TO PASS BEFORE LEAVING. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE UNTIL THE LAST RUNNER AND VEHICLE HAS PASSED YOUR LOCATION. **PLEASE RETURN DIRECTIONAL SIGNS TO TOWERING PINES PARK AT THE REGISTRATION TENT AFTER SHIFT HAS ENDED.**

JOIN US:

PLEASE JOIN US FOR REFRESHMENTS AT TOWERING PINES PARK AFTER YOUR SHIFT, AND STAY TO HELP US LINE THE 1 MILE ROUTE TO CHEER ON FIRE PERSONNEL IN THE 1 MILE FIREFIGHTER CHALLENGE AT 11:15AM.
